To whom it may concern:

Nucor is pleased to announce that to the best of our knowledge, the steel substrate produced by all Nucor Tubular – Republic Conduit divisions does not exceed the concentration limit in the table below. In addition, none of the hazardous substances in the table below are intentionally introduced to the substrate during the manufacturing process:

This includes all Electrogalvanized and Painted conduit products produced at our facilities in Louisville, KY and Cedar Springs, GA. Hot dipped galvanized products from all divisions may be produced with Hexavalent Chromium chemical treatment that may not comply with the Directive. If requested to be RoHS compliant, Nucor Tubular may be able to produce these coated products with a chemical treatment which conforms to the limits listed above. Consult with the appropriate Nucor facility for more information.
